

AUCTION TERMS & CONDITIONS

AUCTION LOCATION:

Animals will be sold via photo/video at the Custer State Park Visitor Center with live internet bidding available. Animals will be sold individually and by gate cut. See individual lots for details.

DIRECTIONS TO CUSTER STATE PARK VISITOR CENTER:

The Custer State Park Visitor Center is located at the intersection of US Highway 16A and the Wildlife Loop Road. It is approximately 14 miles east of Custer, SD and 12 miles west of Hermosa, SD.

ANIMAL VIEWING:

Showing date is Friday, October 31, 2025 and Sale Day (Saturday, Nov. 1) until 9:00 a.m. at the Bison Corrals located on the Wildlife Loop Road.

DIRECTIONS TO CORRALS FOR VIEWING AND LOADOUT:

Take Highway 16A east of Custer 15 miles to the Wildlife Loop Road, and then 9 miles south on the Loop Road to the corrals. From Rapid City, take Highway 79 south for 33 miles, then turn west on to South Lame Johnny Road (Custer County Road #16) for 5 miles. From the Visitor Center, turn left out of the lot and go south on Wildlife Loop Road for 9 miles to the corrals.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

Animals will be sold in lots. Full payment is due on the day of the sale. First time buyer's must present an irrevocable bank letter of credit guaranteeing payment of any check. All bison must be loaded out by 4:30 p.m. unless alternate arrangements have been made with Custer State Park. Yardage fees after Nov. 7th will be \$15/per head/per day. CSP corrals are available for additional testing upon the buyer's request and expense. Buyers are asked to make arrangements and obtain needed permits from their home state veterinarians. Field slaughter scheduled at the corrals, Monday, Nov. 3 through Wednesday, Nov. 5.

HEALTH:

All bison are brucellosis tested. Bison are not TB tested. If TB is required by the importing state, testing can be done at buyer's risk and expense at the Custer State Park corrals. TB animals will not be able to travel until Tuesday, Nov. 4. Health tests expire on Nov. 8. All calves were weaned the second week of October. All calves preconditioned with Vision 7 20/20, Pyramid 5+ Response and Cydectin pour-on dewormer. All females are Official Calfhood Vaccinates (OCV) for brucellosis unless noted. Weights were taken the second week in October and from a true test non-certified scale. No guarantees are implied. Calves have a vaccine withdrawal period for slaughter.

Welcome to the 60th Annual Fall Classic Custer State Park Bison Auction

Welcome to the 60th Annual Custer State Park Bison Auction!

Each year, this auction serves as an important management tool to maintain our bison herd at a sustainable size based on the carrying capacity of our rangelands, while also supporting the growth and genetic diversity of herds across North America.

By 1900, fewer than 1,000 bison were left on the entire continent. Thanks to the vision of South Dakota's 9th Governor, Peter Norbeck, Custer State Park became part of the species' recovery story. In the early 1900s, the then—Custer State Forest and Game Preserve purchased 36 bison to establish the park's herd. Today, Custer State Park manages more than 1,450 bison during the summer months.

Bison are at the heart of Custer State Park. Thousands of visitors each year experience the thrill of seeing these magnificent animals roam freely across the prairie—offering a glimpse of what the Great Plains looked like generations ago. Beyond their iconic presence, bison play a vital ecological role, helping maintain a healthy grassland ecosystem through their natural grazing behaviors that promote native plant diversity.

In partnership with South Dakota State University, Custer State Park continues its commitment to science-based management. In 2021, we began a multi-year research project



studying bison grazing behavior and movement patterns using GPS collars. Data collected from these collars helps us understand how bison use the park landscape, especially following the 2017 Legion Lake Fire. Collars removed in October 2025 will provide valuable insight into the herd's use of the park over multiple seasons, helping us better manage both the animals and their habitat.

All animals sold through this auction qualify for grass-fed only programs. Bison graze exclusively on the park's native mixed-grass prairie and are provided free-choice mineral supplements. No supplemental feeding occurs during the winter months.

Thank you for attending and supporting the 60th Annual Custer State Park Bison Auction. Your participation helps ensure the continued success of this historic herd and contributes to the broader conservation goal of "Bison One Million."
